I need to ask you to communicate to all your team members , family and friends who participate and spectate at match's both at the Laybutt Sporting complex and at all away fields that the expected level of behaviour needs to be in line with all Workers FC and the BDSFA guidelines and policies and that there is a zero tolerance approach without exception, and your awareness and backing is paramount to ensuring the community can attend sport without the fear of being subject to such unacceptable behaviour.

Your committee take no comfort in advising you of these matters, but we do need your support to further prevent such issues from re-occurring.
